
2013 Pool Season Will Soon Be Here!

The 2013 pool season is fast approaching! FCCA has a total of 11 pools. Four of FCCA's pools are set to open on weekends starting May 4th. These pools include Woodstream,

Lexington Colony, Magnolia Plantation and the Aquatic Center Leisure pool. This is the second season for the new Aquatic Center leisure pool.







Scheduled to open the weekend of May 25th are Alcorn Oaks, Austin Park, Creekshire, Heritage Colony, The Lakes, and Crescent Lakes pools. All FCCA pools will be open for summer weekday hours beginning June 7th.

The Austin Park swimming pool is designated at times as a "swim at your own risk" facility. During the periods in which the Austin Park swimming pool is a "swim at your own risk" facility, access to the pool area will require a card key. A \$10.00 fee will be charged for a key.

The Aquatic Center Lap Pool is a "Swim at Your Own Risk" facility. Lifequards are not on duty. Since its main use is as a fitness swimming facility, there will be NO areas of the pool designated leisure swimming areas. Residents are required to submit a \$100 deposit for the pool key.

To enter the FCCA pools you will need to show your pool tag. 2013 pool tag distribution begins Monday, April 15th, at the FCCA office. Bring your driver's license, or a current utility bill as proof of residency. Our office hours are Monday - Friday from 8 am - 5 pm. We will also be open for your convenience on Saturday, May 4th and Saturday, May 25th from 10 am - 2 pm.

You will find the pool schedule in the summer guide coming out in mid- April or the website at www.firstcolony.org beginning in April.

Enjoy FCCA's Amenities

As outdoor activity begins to increase, the Parks and Recreation staff would like to remind everyone of the recreational amenities First Colony offers. At the Aquatic Center Park,

located at 4350 Austin Parkway, the lakeside park amenities include:

- Expanded lakeside trails system
- Two boardwalks that serve as a kayak/canoe launch or fishing pier
- Two scenic lake overlook areas
- Two volleyball courts (non-lighted)

- Two bocce ball courts
- Three horseshoe pits
- Three shaded chess/checker tables overlooking the lake

When the office is open, you may check out equipment to play bocce ball, volleyball or horseshoes. Look for the newly redesigned disc golf course in late spring, early summer. The course is open to play at any time and a tournament will be scheduled later in the year.

First Colony has three set of tennis courts located in the neighborhoods of Woodstream, Lexington Colony and Creekshire. Residents interested in playing are required to get a key to the courts. The deposit for the key is \$20.00 and is refundable when you return the key.

Kayak Fun on Brooks Lake

Come have fun on Brooks Lake by checkingout a kayak at the Oyster Creek Boathouse. The boathouse will open Saturdays and Sundays starting April 27th and runs through

October 27th. Hours of operations are:

- Saturdays: 10 am 7 pm
- Sundays: 1 pm 6 pm
- Open Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day: 10 am 6 pm.

You must be 21 years of age or older to check-out a kayak; rowers under 21 must be accompanied by an adult. There is no cost to check-out a kayak for First Colony Community Association (FCCA) members. You must have a current FCCA pool tag as proof of residency. Pool tags are available to members at the FCCA office located at 4350 Austin Parkway, Sugar Land starting April 15th.

• Office hours are Monday - Friday from 8 am - 5 pm

We will also be open on Saturday, May 4th and May 25th from 10 am - 2 pm.

You will need to show proof of residency to receive a pool tag by providing your driver's license or a current utility bill. At kayak check-out you will be required to leave a driver's license and sign a liability form. Non-residents may check-out a kayak by purchasing a pass at the FCCA office. Reservations are not accepted, as kayaks are checked out on a first come, first served basis. Kayaking experience is not necessary (though it is a good idea to have a general knowledge of rowing). In addition, life preservers are provided to all participants. Don't forget to bring along sun block and drinking water. The boathouse is located at 15910 Creekbend Dr. Check out the website at <u>www.firstcolony.org</u> under Parks and Recreation to see all the details including a kayak trail map of the area, liability form, and Kayak 101. Note: An application must be submitted for approval prior to the commencement of any type of exterior change or construction on the property.

Adopt-A-Park Program

If you're looking for a unique volunteer opportunity, the Adopt-A-Park Program is a brand new way you can help our community! The program's goal is to



assist the First Colony Operations Department with keeping our neighborhood parks safe and clean. A volunteer chooses a park to adopt and then provides support and reports about their park to our Operations Department. Volunteer opportunities include keeping our parks beautiful by cleaning up litter, monitoring and inspecting parks and park equipment, and providing support and encouragement for other volunteers. All that we ask is that a volunteer be able to meet a one year commitment. At the end of that year, a volunteer may renew, change parks, or terminate their commitment. Monitoring the parks should be done on a regular basis, usually once a week during the warm season and when weather permits during the cold season. Depending on the park usage, some parks may require additional time commitments or additional volunteers. A volunteer should provide reports on hours spent monitoring a park or performing any volunteer responsibilities, any maintenance issues discovered after inspecting, any injuries witnessed, etc. All volunteers should remember that we should include all park users that wish to be involved with projects at the park and continue our wonderful welcoming community by working together. If there are any maintenance problems or improvement ideas beyond the scope of the Adopt-A-Park Program, FCCA will consider and review the proposals.
